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Overall Goal:


Minimize number of staff in the room while providing appropriate response to Neonatal Code.

Additional staff should remain outside of the room unless requested.

- ALL STAFF ENTERING ROOM OF PUI OR COVID-19 POSITIVE PATIENT MUST WEAR ENHANCED DROPLET/ AIRBORNE PRECAUTIONS.
- > DELIVERY BAG WILL BE LEFT OUTSIDE OF ROOM.

In cases of limited staff availability, delivery bag may be brought into room when needed and cleansed afterwards (not preferred).

- > Sites should change delivery room bag packaging to enable appropriate cleaning and supply conservation.
- > Staff may assume more than one role.
- Provider #2, Recorder, Pharmacist, and Runner need to remain outside of room.
- > Voalte phone will be utilized on speaker with door closed as much as possible.
- > ANM will remain outside to coordinate, if staffing allows.
- ANM/RN team leader/ NNP may assist with obtaining supplies from delivery bag/cart.
 - Supplies will be handed off to an available staff member inside the room.
- RN team leader/ NNP to request meds from Pharmacist.
 - Labeled medications will be handed through door to available staff.



Ensure double verification of medication and closed loop communication between all team members.
