Position Overview

This is a full-time position for a Board-Certified or Board-Eligible Neonatologist at Holy Cross Health, which has one of the largest delivery services in the country. We are a vibrant private practice comprised of Neonatologists, Pediatricians, and Neonatal Nurse Practitioners. Your time will be mostly at our busy 46-bed Level III NICU in Silver Spring, Maryland. You will also cover some shifts at our 8-bed Level II NICU in Germantown, Maryland, where we also provide well newborn care. We provide delivery room services at both locations. We also have a specialized Tiny Baby Program for newborns less than 1000 grams at birth. We work closely with specialists from Children's National Medical Center and are a teaching site for their Pediatric residents.

- In-house call coverage and day coverage
- Perform up-to-date diagnostic and treatment procedures
- Attend high-risk deliveries

- Assist in the development of policies and procedures for the operation of the Division of Neonatal Perinatal Medicine
- Comply with all applicable by-laws, rules, regulations, policies and procedures of the Division of Neonatal Perinatal Medicine
- Attend appropriate continuing professional education programs to assure maintenance of adequate levels of professional competence
- Other duties as assigned
